

RUNOFF ELECTIONS 2017

Following the 2017 November Special Elections, 4 statewide offices, and several local offices required an additional election to determine newly elected officials, as initial votes were either tied or too close to determine a single winner. While Runoff Elections are mandated when no candidate secures 50% of vote, the ballot becomes limited to the two candidates who accrued the majority vote. Results for the Georgia Legislature that were determined during the 2017 December runoff are as follows:
