ACIP Vaccination Plan Guidance

Non-binding information from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention

The CDC's **Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP)** met this past weekend to produce guidance on continued vaccine roll-out. This guidance is *not binding* but will be utilized by states as they refine their vaccination plans.

States have the final determination on how vaccines are prioritized and will be sharing additional details. Georgia's current plan is [here](#).

Highlights

Currently, states are in **phase 1a** which focuses on high risk healthcare workers and long term care facilities.

ACIP 1b recommendations include prioritizing:

- Persons 75 years and older
- First-responders not yet vaccinated
- K12 teachers, staff and childcare workers
- Critical workers in high risk settings such as food and agriculture, manufacturing, and grocery store workers, among others
- Homeless shelters or group homes for individuals with disabilities
- Corrections workers and people in prisons and detention centers

ACIP 1c recommendations include prioritizing:

- Persons between 65 and 74 years old
- Persons between 16 to 64 years old with high risk medical conditions
- Other essential workers including transportation and logistics, food service, finance, IT and communication, energy, and construction, among others
