Vaccine Coordination Effort

The Federal Emergency Management Agency ([FEMA](#)) launched a [new vaccine support website](#) today, which provides resources related to vaccine distribution and administration. In addition, Healthcare Ready provided an overview of the [resource page](#) they have available for the healthcare and public health community. Stakeholders can also view the [NGA webpage](#) on state approaches to phased allocation vaccines and this [Bloomberg webpage](#) for a COVID-19 vaccine tracker.

The Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency ([CISA](#)) provided an update from the COVID Task Force which continues to support federal efforts on vaccine production and distribution. The Task Force's Risk Management subgroup is focusing on early warning analysis and issue identification. For example, they are assisting FEMA in using the [Defense Production Act](#) to address medical supply shortages. They are also supporting the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention ([CDC](#)) in the prioritization of vaccine administration to frontline workers, as well as supporting the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services ([HHS](#)) through a newly established Vaccine Acceleration working group. The Task Force also stands ready to support FEMA with mass vaccination sites.

As of January 28, 2021, there have been **25,456,670 cases** and **427,626 deaths** in the U.S. There have been **26,193,682 vaccine doses** administered nationally.
