2022 LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT & TAXATION

- Support current tax incentives and economic development policies that have proven to attract investment and create jobs in the state
- Promote tax policies that incentivize growth and provide economic stability to Georgia's growing technology industries
- Support policies to assist in privately funded technological infrastructure advancements in rural communities aiding small businesses, colleges, hospitals, and local governments

EMPLOYMENT

- Preserve Georgia's employment-at-will doctrine and the state's right-to-work status
- Preserve employers' ability to maintain a safe business environment for employees

ENERGY & NATURAL RESOURCES

- Protect statewide access to sustainable, reliable, and affordable energy supplies
- Enhance access to high-quality, affordable water supplies and ensuring future water supply security for communities and businesses across the state.

HEALTH & WELLNESS

- Support a state-led approach to ensure the viability of our healthcare system by supporting implementation of federal waiver programs to help small businesses with premium assistance as well as increase access to care for more Georgians
- Support policies that promote the development of a talented and qualified workforce across the healthcare continuum
- Promote cost containment with respect to employer-sponsored health Insurance

LEGAL REFORM

- Extend liability protections from COVID-19 exposure for healthcare workers, facilities and businesses
- Establish liability protections based on a plaintiff's status as an invitee, licensee, or trespasser on landowners' property
